The School of Education and Human Services requests approval to establish the Early Childhood Education Department. This proposal is the result of numerous and extensive discussions between the dean, the Executive Committee and the Department of Education.

The new department will consist of three current full-time, tenure track faculty members. We intend on additional faculty within the next one to three years.

Structure, representation and administration of said department would include, but not be limited to, the Early Childhood Development Center, legitimated as an administration of the academic enterprise of the School of Education and Human Services.
