Subject: Faculty Governance Update

At the regularly scheduled University Senate and Senate Assembly meetings on March 17, Senate and Senate Assembly members will elect the University Senate Secretary and four new members of the Senate Advisory Committee on University Affairs (SACUA) to replace outgoing members whose terms have expired.
