Background and Summary:

Attached is the Monthly Investment Report for the Long Term Portfolio as of January 31, 2016.

- Page 1 summarizes the assets as of January 31, 2016. Allocations to Alternative Assets (Illiquid) reflect market values as of September 30, 2015, the most recent date available, adjusted for contributions and distributions through January 31, 2016. Alternative Assets (Illiquid) are valued on a quarterly basis. December 31, 2015, data is not available due to the time involved with gathering the requisite information from the partnerships.
- Page 2 reports the performance of the Marketable Securities by asset class for select periods ending January 31, 2016. Performance for Alternative Assets (Illiquid) is reported only quarterly, as these investments are valued on a quarterly basis.
