SUBJECT: Clarification of new Degree Program


At the July 20, 2017 Board of Regents meeting there was an agenda item from Chancellor Borrego and then Provost Knerr requesting the creation of a new degree program, the Doctor of Nurse Anesthesia Practice (DNAP) in the School of Health Professions and Studies at the University of Michigan-Flint. This recommendation was approved by the regents at that time.

This item for information clarifies that this new degree was effective as of January 1, 2018 for all degrees awarded in the Doctor of Nurse Anesthesia Practice degree program on and after that date. The request was not and is not intended to be retroactively applied to graduates of other programs.
