At the July 20, 2017 Board of Regents meeting there was an agenda item from Chancellor Borrego and then Provost Knerr requesting the creation of a new degree program, the Doctor of Nurse Anesthesia Practice (DNAP) in the School of Health Professions and Studies at the University of Michigan-Flint.
