ACTION REQUEST

SUBJECT: 2010-2011 Fee Assessments for Michigan Student Assembly (MSA),
Student Legal Services (SLS), and School/College Governments

ACTION REQUESTED: Approval of the following fee assessments:
\$7.19 per student per term for MSA (*no change from 2009-10*);
\$6.00 per student per term for SLS (*no change from 2009-10*); and
\$1.50 per student per term for School/College governments (*no change
from 2009-10*).

Background: At the June 2009 Regents' Meeting, the Regents reauthorized a fee of \$7.19 per student per term for MSA, \$6.00 per student per term for Student Legal Services and \$1.50 per student per term for School/College governments.

MSA, SLS and School/College Government Fees: This year, Michigan Student Assembly believes that the current fee structure will provide adequate funding for the coming fiscal year (see attached memorandum). The Division of Student Affairs believes that Student Legal Services will have sufficient resources for 2010-2011 under the current fee structure. We also believe the school and college government organizations are adequately funded. Therefore, no increase is being requested for MSA, SLS or School/College Governments.

Recommendations: I recommend approval of the following fees for 2010-2011: \$7.19 per student per term for Michigan Student Assembly, \$6.00 per student per term for Student Legal Services, and \$1.50 per student per term for School/College governments.


