SUBJECT: Proposed Flint FY 2006-2007 Tuition & Fees Rates

ACTION REQUESTED: Approval of 2006-2007 Tuition & Fees Rates


BACKGROUND:

The proposed FY 2006-2007 Tuition and Fee rates include a 3.0% increase in State funding and a 7.9% increase in combined tuition and fees for resident undergraduate students (and 4% for graduates) from the rates approved by the Regents for FY 2005-2006.

The FY 2006-2007 General Fund budget, in the companion Action Item, increases student financial aid 10.0%, 2.1% above the proposed increase in combined tuition and fees.

We request approval of the proposed FY 2006-2007 combined tuition and fee rates.

Footnotes

(1) The percentage increase for tuition and fees combined is 7.9% for undergraduates and 4% for graduates.

(2) The reported rate for NetPlus represents a rate per term. This is a two-year program with four terms per year.

(3) The increase in the technology fee is necessary to keep up with the costs of providing students with state of the art technology.

(4) The increase in the Recreation Center Fee is necessary to keep up with cost increases and to increase services to our students.
