Proposed Flint FY 2007-2008 Tuition & Fees Rates

ACTION REQUESTED: Approval of 2007-2008 Tuition & Fees Rates

BACKGROUND:

The proposed FY 2007-2008 Tuition and Fee rates assume the August 2007 deferred payment is fully restored and that 40% of the FY 2006-2007 funding increase is maintained for FY 2007-08. These rates include a 6.4% increase in combined tuition and fees for resident undergraduate students (and 5.0% for graduates) from the rates approved by the Regents for FY 2006-2007.

The FY 2007-2008 General Fund budget, in the companion Action Item, increases student financial aid 8.4%, 2.0% above the proposed increase in combined tuition and fees.

We request approval of the proposed FY 2007-2008 combined tuition and fee rates.
