Subject: Michigan Medicine  
University Hospital South  
Roof Replacement

Action  
Requested: Approval to Proceed with Project

Background:

The University Hospital South buildings have aging roof systems that are beyond their useful lives. Several areas are leaking and repair costs are escalating to a point where replacement is recommended in order to reduce maintenance costs and prevent future damage. This project will replace roof systems in an area of approximately 60,000 square feet, addressing those with the most need. There will be no impact on parking from this project


The estimated cost of the project is \$4,800,000. Funding will be provided from Health System resources. The construction cash flow may be provided, all or in part, by bond proceeds or increasing the commercial paper issuance under the commercial paper program, secured by a pledge of General Revenues, and authorized by the Board of Regents. The architectural firm of Niagara Murano will design the project. The project is expected to provide an average of nine on-site construction jobs. Construction is scheduled to be completed in the fall of 2019.

We recommend that the Board of Regents approve the Michigan Medicine University Hospital South Roof Replacement project as described and authorize issuing the project for bids and awarding construction contracts providing that bids are within the approved budget.
