Often these funds are expended over several years, making comparisons between awards and expenditures somewhat misleading. Research expenditures are presented here to provide a trend line for the current fiscal year.

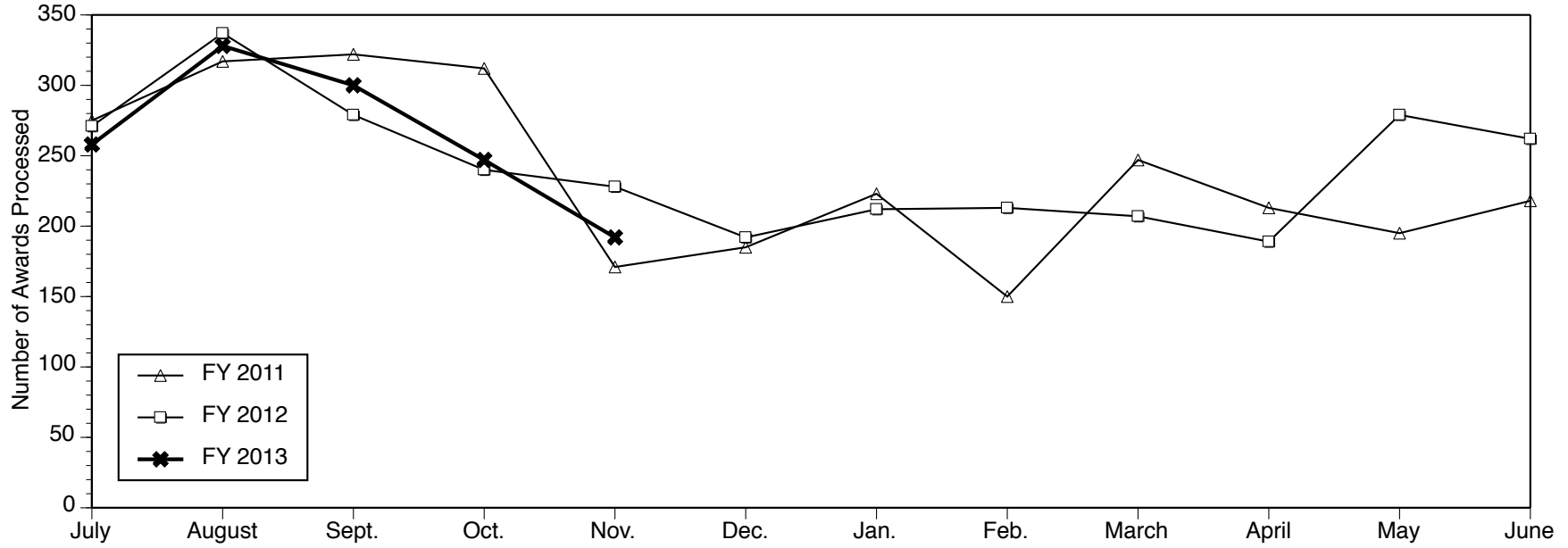
There were 36 fewer awards processed in November 2012 when compared with the previous November 2011. However the value of November 2012 awards increased by \$14.7 million over November 2011. The receipt of a \$21.5 million award primarily causes this dollar value increase for the "Center for HIV RNA Studies". As may be recalled, last month another large award totaling \$28.4 million was also processed.

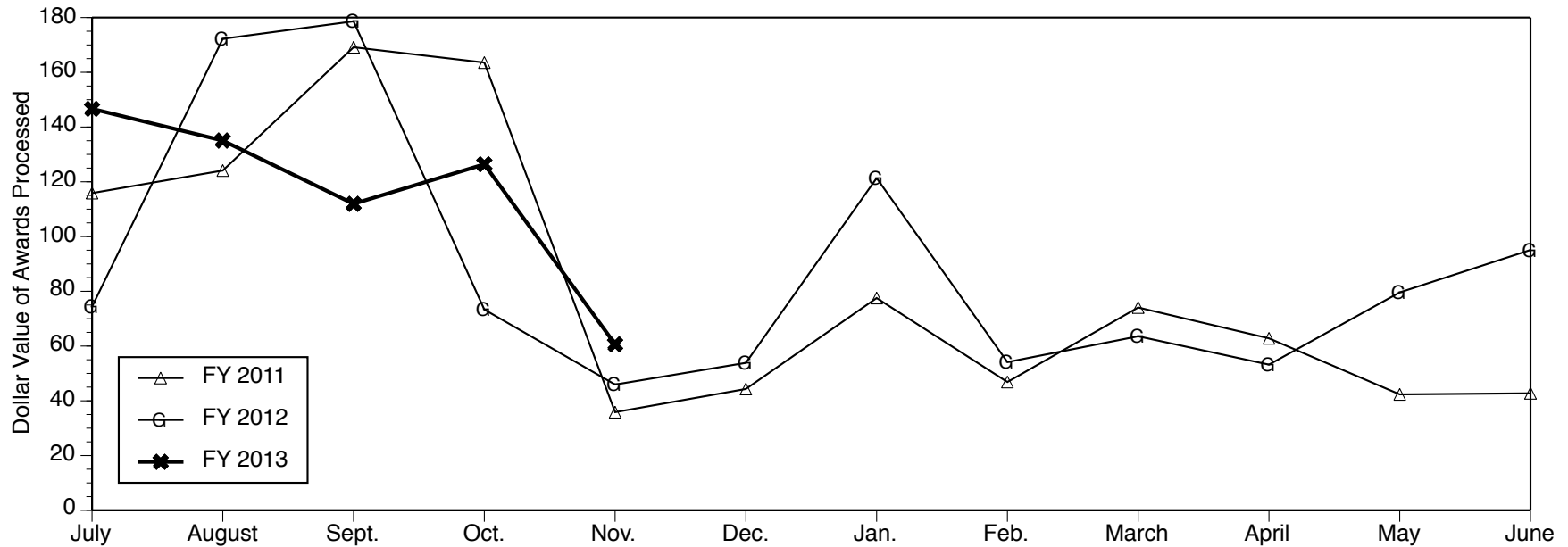
