ACTION REQUEST: Approval of Department Name Change in the College of Education, Health, and Human Services

CURRENT NAMES: Department of Community and Public Health, and Department of Social Work

RECOMMENDED NAME: Department of Health and Human Services

EFFECTIVE DATE: December 1, 2013

The Governing Faculty of the College of Education, Health, and Human Services, at its September 20, 2013 meeting, approved the establishment of a new department: Department of Health and Human Services.

This combines the two department names (Department of Community and Public Health, and Department of Social Work) that were initially included in the December 2012 Regents Communication to rename the School of Education to the College of Education, Health, and Human Services.

This action is fully supported by the dean of the College of Education, Health, and Human Services as well as the provost and vice chancellor for Academic Affairs. I am pleased to present this recommendation for your approval.
