

U-M Research Award and Expenditures Report: December 2017

This report summarizes the overall trends in research activity across all three campuses of the University of Michigan through September 30, 2017.


Figure 1 shows that total research expenditures through the third month of fiscal year 2018 are ahead of the previous year by 4.4 percent. It is important to note that total research expenditures for fiscal year 2017, which closed on June 30, reached a record high of \$1.48 billion.




FIGURE 2: SUBMISSIONS BY COUNT





FIGURE 3: SUBMISSIONS BY AMOUNT

The number of research submissions in September exceeded the number from last September, as shown in Figure 2, and the total for the year is now 0.9 percent ahead of our pace from the previous year. Figure 3 shows the value of those submissions are down 12.9 percent year to date compared to the first three months of fiscal year 2017.

Figures 4 and 5 show the number of new research awards from external sponsors are down 4 percent, though their value has increased by 3.2 percent when compared to the previous fiscal year.

Submissions By Count


