Subject: Faculty Governance Update

SACUA would like to acknowledge the Regents long and difficult, but momentous, effort to select President-elect Mark S. Schlissel as the next president of University of Michigan. SACUA hopes to meet with President Schlissel before he arrives permanently on campus, or as soon after he officially takes office as possible. It is our impression, from informal conversations, that the President-elect looks forward to the opportunity to speak with faculty.
