I am pleased to recommend the appointment of Ravi Pendse as vice president for information technology and chief information officer, Office of the President, effective August 1, 2018 through June 30, 2023.

As vice president for information technology and chief information officer (VPIT-CIO), Mr. Pendse will serve as an executive officer of the university and provide university-wide leadership and strategic direction for information technology.

Mr. Pendse currently serves as the vice president for computing and information services and chief information officer at Brown University. In this position, Mr. Pendse is a member of president's cabinet and oversees the technology infrastructure throughout Brown's campus, encompassing a combined annual budget of more than \$40 million. Mr. Pendse is also a Brown University professor of computer science and engineering and in this capacity has been an active researcher, teacher and advisor to students. He has secured more than \$21 million in external research grants, published numerous scholarly articles and received several teaching awards. Prior to joining Brown University, Mr. Pendse was at Wichita State University, rising through the ranks from a teaching fellow to a professor and vice president for information technology and chief information officer (1992-2013). Mr. Pendse began his academic career as an assistant professor in the College of Engineering and Technology at Northern Arizona University (1989-1992).

Mr. Pendse holds a B.S in electronics and communication engineering from Osmania University in Hyderabad, India. He received his M.S. and Ph.D. in electrical engineering from Wichita State University.

In addition to his substantial academic and professional credentials, Mr. Pendse will bring his extensive experience as a successful and collaborative university leader.
