**Action Requested: Adoption of Retirement Memoir**


**Kirk Philipich, D.B.A.**, associate professor of accounting and finance in the University of Michigan-Dearborn College of Business, retired from active faculty status on December 31, 2019.

Professor Philipich received his B.S.B.A. (1977) degree from Saint Louis University and his M.B.A. (1981) and D.B.A. (1984) degrees from Indiana University. Professor Philipich served on the faculties of the University of Notre Dame, Saint Louis University, and The Ohio State University. He joined the University of Michigan-Dearborn faculty as an assistant professor in 2005 and was promoted to associate professor in 2011.

Professor Philipich was a dedicated teacher and scholar. He published articles in a number of journals, including the *Journal of Accounting Research*, *Financial Analysts Journal*, *Financial Management*, *Accounting Horizons*, *Advances in Accounting*, *CPA Journal*, *Journal of Business Cases and Applications*, and *Oil, Gas & Energy Quarterly*. He taught a wide variety of courses at the undergraduate and graduate levels. In the College of Business, he served as chair of the Curriculum Committee (2010-11), as a member of the Executive Committee (2010-11), and as chair of the Graduate Curriculum Committee (2012-13).

The Regents now salute this dedicated scholar and educator for his service to the university by naming **Kirk Philipich, associate professor emeritus of accounting and finance**.
