SUBJECT: Proposed Flint FY 2011-2012 Tuition & Fees Rates

ACTION REQUESTED: Approval of 2011-2012 Tuition & Fees Rates

BACKGROUND:


The proposed FY 2011-2012 Tuition and Fee rates assume a 14.7% decrease in state funding. These rates include a 6.8% increase in combined tuition and fees for resident undergraduate students (and 4.9% for graduates) from the rates approved by the Regents for FY 2010-2011.

The FY 2011-2012 General Fund budget, in the companion Action Item, increases student financial aid 8.8%, 2% above the proposed increase in combined tuition and fees.

The proposed budget includes our state appropriation of approximately \$17.8 million.

We request approval of the proposed FY 2011-2012 combined tuition and fee rates.
