Ms. Schrader has 24 years of progressively responsible experience in the field of non-profit development and has extensive experience with planned giving and major gift fundraising, campaign and strategic planning along with years of communication experience. Since 2008, Ms. Schrader has served as the chief development officer for the Purdue Research Foundation, Purdue Polytechnic Institute.
