Action Requested: Adoption of Retirement Memoir

**Brian Patrick Green, Ph.D.,** professor of accounting, College of Business, University of Michigan-Dearborn, retired from active faculty status on June 30, 2025.

Professor Green received his Bachelor of Science degree in accounting in 1979 and his M.B.A. in 1981 from Central Michigan University and became a certified public accountant in 1983. He earned his Ph.D. in accounting from Kent State University in 1991. Professor Green began his career as an internal auditor for the U.S. Army and held several positions in public accounting and academia before joining the University of Michigan-Dearborn's College of Business as an assistant professor in 1992. He was promoted to associate professor in 1998 and professor in 2003.

Professor Green is a dedicated researcher, teacher, and colleague. He has published over 80 articles in the field, including leading academic, professional, and pedagogical journals such as *Auditing: A Journal of Practice & Theory, CPA Journal*, and *Advances in Accounting Education*. He was awarded the Richard Czarnecki Endowed Collegiate Professorship four times, from 2008 to 2020, College of Business Distinguished Performance in Research in 2014, University Distinguished Professor of the Year in 2011, and University Distinguished Faculty Research Award in 2000. For his teaching, he was given the University's Distinguished Teaching award in 2017.

Professor Green was also recognized by the Michigan Association of CPAs with their Distinguished Achievement in Accounting Education award in 2009, following their Educator of the Year award in 2003. He has also served the accounting discipline and the university in a variety of leadership roles over his career.

The Regents now salute this dedicated scholar and educator for his dedicated service to the university by naming **Brian Patrick Green**, **professor emeritus of accounting**.
