Subject: Implementation of the Regents' Policy on Research Grants, Contracts, and Agreements, FY06

A. <u>The Regents' Policy</u>

In April 1987 the Regents approved a policy on openness in research grants, contracts, and agreements. The policy outlines the principles to be used in balancing open scholarly exchange and academic freedom in those rare instance in which they conflict. By policy, the Vice President for Research consults annually with the Senate Assembly Research Policy Committee (RPC) and then reports to the Regents.

B. <u>Implementation Procedures for the Regents' Policy</u>

The Vice President for Research has implemented procedures for the Regents' Policy that

- a) Define certain contract restrictions that are "standard" and which may be accepted directly by our research contract negotiators.
- b) Require higher level review and approval for acceptance of classified research contracts and those containing "non-standard" language.
- C. Experience during FY06

In FY06, the Vice President reviewed two (2) new requests for approval of contractual restrictions on openness from two different academic units. These requests represented 0.04% of the 4,733 proposals submitted and 0.11% of the 1,743 awards accepted during that same period.

D. Policy Experience, FY88-FY06

The Vice President for Research has submitted an Information Item to the Regents annually since FY88. The table below shows that the number of requests for non-standard restrictions represent a very small and relatively stable proportion of research agreements proposed or accepted by the University. The University conducts very little classified research.
