

There was a dramatic decline in the total dollar value of awards processed in June 2013 when compared with June 2012. Overall there was nearly no growth in total awards processed in terms of number and dollar value at year-end. Research awards experienced a decline in both number and dollar value for the month of June as well year-end. There were 239 fewer research awards in FY 2013 compared with FY 2012 resulting in a decline of nearly \$54 million.


