Action Requested: Adoption of Retirement Memoir

Raffi Indjejikian, Ph.D., Carlton H. Griffin–Deloitte & Touche LLP Collegiate Professor of Accounting and professor of accounting in the Stephen M. Ross School of Business, retired from active faculty status on May 24, 2026.

Professor Indjejikian received his Bachelor of Commerce degree with Great Distinction from McGill University, a Diploma in Public Accountancy from McGill University, his M.B.A. from the University of Western Ontario, and his Ph.D. from the Wharton School of the University of Pennsylvania. He began his academic career as an assistant professor at the University of Chicago in 1989 and was promoted to associate professor in 1992. In 1996, he joined the University of Michigan as an associate professor and was promoted to professor in 2000.

A leading scholar in managerial and financial accounting, Professor Indjejikian's research has significantly advanced understanding of performance measurement, incentives, and organizational design. His work, widely published in premier journals such as *The Accounting Review*, *Journal of Accounting Research*, and *Journal of Accounting and Economics*, has shaped the field's approach to compensation systems, information flows, and decision-making within firms. In addition to his scholarly contributions, he has been a dedicated and highly regarded educator across MBA, executive, and doctoral programs, earning multiple teaching awards including the Ph.D. Teaching Excellence Award at Ross. His service to the academic profession is extensive, including editorial roles at leading journals and participation on numerous editorial boards. Within the university, he has contributed meaningfully through leadership roles such as accounting area chair, chair of the Ross Curriculum Committee, member of the U-M's Senate Assembly and the President's Principals Committee, and long-standing service to doctoral education.
