
Requested: Approval of Concessionaire's Application for Liquor License

Background:

In February 2012, the Board of Regents approved licensing the use of Michigan Stadium to NHL Enterprises for the 2013 Bridgestone National Hockey League (NHL) Winter Classic between the Detroit Red Wings and Toronto Maple Leafs on January 1, 2013 (with a contingency date of January 2, 2013). At that time, it was anticipated that the University of Michigan would obtain a special liquor license to allow the sale of alcohol at the game. Public Act 212 of 2012, approved in June 2012, modified the Michigan Liquor Control Code Section 531(7) to allow the Michigan Stadium concessionaire to apply for a liquor license for the event. Under the Michigan Liquor Control Code, the Board of Regents must provide local government approval for the concessionaire's application for the liquor license.

We recommend that the Board of Regents approve the application for a Class C License and Catering Permit by Sodexo Management Inc. for the 2013 Bridgestone NHL Winter Classic hockey game to be held at Michigan Stadium on January 1, 2013 (with a contingency date of January 2, 2013).
