Subject: Regional Clinically Integrated Network (CIN)

Action Requested: Approve the creation of a new regional U-M Health CIN and the dissolution of two existing CINs

Background:

For the past two years, leadership from the Michigan Medicine Department of Strategy, Michigan Medicine, UM Health-Sparrow, and UM Health-West have met as a Population Health Workgroup to coordinate activities and identify a broader health system strategy for population health. The Population Health Workgroup transitioned its focus from strategic planning to a select set of initiatives meant to drive and align the population health strategy across U-M Health. One of those initiatives was to optimize our Clinical Integrated Network (CIN). Specifically, to create a unified, leading statewide CIN that aligns with our accountable care organization (ACO). A unified CIN and population health strategy will improve administrative efficiency and performance by reducing administrative complexity and redundancy. The creation of this new statewide CIN will also lead to the dissolution of the two existing CINs (Sparrow Care Network (SCN) and Metro Health Integrated Network (MHIN)).

We recommend that the Board of Regents approve the creation of a new regional U-M Health CIN and the future dissolution of the two existing CINs, Sparrow Care Network (SCN) and Metro Health Integrated Network (MHIN).
