**Action Requested: Adoption of Retirement Memoir**


**Jianming Xiang, M.D.**, associate research scientist, neurosurgery in the Crosby Neurosurgical Laboratories, Medical School, retired from active faculty status on August 31, 2025.

Dr Xiang received his M.D. from Kunming Medical College in 1982. He joined the University of Michigan faculty as a research assistant II in 1991, and was promoted to research associate I in 1992, research associate II in 1996, senior research associate in 2002, research investigator in 2004, assistant research scientist in 2011, and associate research scientist in 2017.

Dr. Xiang has extensive experience in the choroid plexus (blood-cerebrospinal fluid barrier) and the blood-brain barrier, and particularly ion, amino acid and drug transport. He has over 60 peer-reviewed journal articles. Dr. Xiang was the co-investigator on five RO1 grants. He has mentored over 15 students and postdoctoral fellows.
