Action Requested: Accept gift of land


Background:

Thanks to the generosity of our donors, Michigan Medicine is poised to expand its services with the development of two interconnected facilities in Troy, creating a new specialty care campus. This initiative includes the establishment of a state-of-the-art outpatient center for cardiovascular services, extending the collaborative and innovative care model pioneered in Ann Arbor. Additionally, a cutting-edge advanced imaging center will be introduced, providing the latest in imaging technology and groundbreaking treatment capabilities.

This new campus will greatly improve convenience and access for patients across the tri-county area, particularly benefiting those for whom travel to Ann Arbor presents challenges.

To make this vision a reality, approximately five acres of land located near the Frances and Kenneth Eisenberg Troy Center for Specialty Care have been generously and anonymously donated. We recommend that the Board of Regents accept this land gift.


