Research Agreement between the University of Michigan and

Arbor Ultrasound Technologies, LLC

Action Requested:

Authorization to enter into Research Agreement

Preamble:

A statutory conflict of interest situation was identified by the Division of Research Development and Administration while reviewing the Proposal Approval Form which then triggered a review by the Medical School Conflict of Interest Board. A plan for management of the possible risks associated with the conflicts of interest was then developed by the Board and agreed to by the parties involved.

This proposed agreement ("Agreement") falls under the State of Michigan Conflict of Interest Statute because Professor William F. (Rick) Weitzel is both an employee of the University of Michigan ("University") and a partial owner of Arbor Ultrasound Technologies, LLC (the "Company"). The law permits such an Agreement provided it is disclosed to the executive officers and approved in advance by a 2/3 vote of the Regents of the University of Michigan.

Background:

Dr. William F. (Rick) Weitzel, a professor in Internal Medicine, is the partial owner of a for-profit company called Arbor Ultrasound Technologies LLC (the "Company"). The Company was formed to commercialize medical devices based on the use of ultrasound for dialysis vascular access monitoring and desires to support research at the University of Michigan related to that technology.

Agreement Terms:

The terms of the proposed Agreement conform to University policy. Jonathan Segal, Assistant Professor of Internal Medicine, will direct the project over an initial sixmonth period at an estimated cost of \$45,000. Since research projects are often amended, these agreements include provisions for changes in time, amount, and scope of each supported project. University procedures for approval of these changes will be followed and additional conflict of interest review will be done as appropriate.

Impact of the Agreement:

This Agreement will enable further research that will assist the Company and Michigan in developing this process technology.

Recommendation:

This matter was reviewed and approved by the Medical School Conflict of Interest Board. In light of the disclosures made in this document and our finding that the Agreement will be negotiated in conformance with standard University practices, I recommend that the Board of Regents approve of the University's entering into this Agreement with Arbor Ultrasound Technologies LLC.
